

Additional “I Will If You Will” challenges by Marina Bay Sands

In line with Sands ECO360° Global Sustainability strategy, hospitality leader Las Vegas Sands is pledging to plant a tree for each participating Team Member at the property that achieves the highest participation rate in Earth Hour. Staff can make their own “I Will If You Will” pledge, challenging other staff to do the same. This challenge will reach over 40,000 Team Members across all the properties owned by Las Vegas Sands, spanning Las Vegas, Pennsylvania, Macau and Singapore. This is in addition to property-specific challenges that each integrated resort has committed to embark on for Earth Hour 2013.

In Singapore, Marina Bay Sands will be participating in Earth Hour 2013 in a bigger and significant way this year, committing to two “I Will If You Will” challenges that reach out to its immediate community: buildings around Marina Bay as well as the integrated resort’s vendors.
