- I. Mission of Department: WWF is the world's largest conservation organization and our mission is to conserve nature and reduce the most pressing threats to the diversity of life on Earth and every day our field fundraising team helps us achieve this mission by speaking with people to let them know about our conservation work, inspiring them to contribute financially.
- II. **Major Functions:** Face to face Fundraising Team Leader position will be a critical role in the WWF Fundraising team. Your role will be to build a new team of 5-6 sales professional who fundraising in various locations (shopping centres, street locations, and events) to help raise awareness about WWF's conservation work and secure ongoing donations. You role will be to lead from within your team, help develop core sales and fundraising skills and drive KPI's by training, coaching and motivating your staff.

You must have a positive attitude towards meeting new people, be available 5-6 shifts from Monday to Sunday on rescheduled work hours 10 am - 7 pm, and have the motivation to inspire the general public to sign up as a monthly sponsor for our amazing conservation work.

- Manage a team of staff who directly engage with the general public on a day-to-day basis, through road shows, events and house visits
- Coach, manage, train, and motivate your team to exceed their financial and non-financial KPIs
- Lead from the front and spend the majority of your time fundraising alongside staff members.
- Create public awareness to support global conservation efforts
- Assist from time to time with recruitment of staff or initial training of team members
- Be well-versed with WWF's goals and objectives for awareness and education to the prospective donors
- Attend regular training and discussions for improvement
- Potentially assist in delivering trainings along with manager
