## **JOB DESCRIPTION**

**Position title:** Communications Officer, Graphic Design and Web Content Management

**Reports to:** Communications Manager, WWF Coastal East Africa Initiative

**Location:** Nairobi, Kenya

**Duration:** 2 years (with possibility of extension)

I. Mission of the Department: To ensure relevant and accurate communications in regard to Kenya, Tanzania and Mozambique on conservation issues, and in places that are key for WWF CEA-I conservation priorities.

## II. Major Functions

Ensure that the WWF Coastal East Africa Initiative (CEA-I) communicates impact of its Conservation Programme through Graphic Design and Web Content that is of the highest quality and relevance to Kenya, Tanzania, Mozambique and the world and to the implementation of the CEA-I Conservation Strategy, in line with that of WWF-AFRICA and WWF International overall Communications Strategy.

## III. Major Duties and Responsibilities

- Undertakes Graphic Design and web content management services as directed by Communications Manager or CEA-I Leader;
- Provides support in communication that promotes conservation impact/outcome to inspire action by the identified target audiences;
- Disseminates information in appropriate online media, as appropriate for different target audiences, that clearly explain WWF Coastal East Africa Initiative role in conservation and its relevance to the Kenyan, Tanzanian and Mozambican societies;
- Maintains an updated www.panda.org/cea website;
- Maintains and updates Facebook and Twitter pages for WWF CEA-I
- Ensures effective knowledge and information management, and ensures that these are available to WWF Kenya staff and the WWF Network;
- Delivers monthly e-newsletter (mail chimp) and a yearly designed and printed newsletter;
- Performs other duties as requested by the Communications Manager, CEA-I Leader and the entire CEA-I Team.
