## Close the Gigatonne Gap

### Be true to science

and agree global emissions to peak by 2015 to prevent runaway dangerous climate change

### Historical emitters must lead

a seamless transition to a 2<sup>nd</sup> commitment period of the Kyoto Protocol (KP) with ambitious binding mitigation targets and with similar commitments from those developed countries who are not party to this commitment period of the KP

### Contributing to the global effort

whereby all Developing countries should submit nationally appropriate actions as part of their fair share of the global effort to address climate change, with the support of developed countries

## Protect our vulnerable people and places

### Protect the vulnerable

by taking measures to deal with existing and future impacts of climate change especially for the vulnerable, including compensation for loss and damage

**Doha must lay the basis for a fair, ambitious and binding agreement by 2015**

### Save our forests

by taking urgent action to stop the destruction and degradation of our forests and ensure that funds are available for this.

## Finance Climate Action

### Financing the Fund

Developed countries should commit immediate funding to the Green Climate Fund from 2013 to support developing countries to reduce emissions and deal with the impacts of climate change

### Meeting the \$100 bn commitment

whereby Developed countries must mobilise resources to meet their \$100bn per annum by 2020 commitment

### Raising money from international transport

by agreeing on a win-win solution to address emissions from the shipping and aviation sector and raise finance for climate action
