Who Can Apply?

- Youth aged between 15- 30 years
- Applicant must be enrolled in an institute or should have a valid degree of last attended institute

How It Works?

- Youth Groups are taken to biodiversity hotspots, national parks, and conservation/ information centers to meet experts and get engaged in the on-field conservation work.
- Main features include;
 - a) Outdoor Orientation/ Information Session
 - b) Bioblitz Activity
 - c) GPS navigation
 - d) Camping
 - e) Bird watching
 - f) Leadership and Teambuilding
 - g) Hiking and Trekking
 - h) Ecotourism Session
- Main Locations;
 - a) Margallah Hills National Park – Hiking Trails (Day Trip)
 - b) Ayubia National Park (Day Trip)
- Participants will get **Certification** after successful completion of the activity.
