The Independent Panel of Experts renews its invitation for the submissions of information for consideration as part of the [Independent Review](#). The deadline for submissions is 29 February 2020. The Panel encourages earlier submissions where possible.

Submissions should be relevant to the [statement of objectives](#) for the Independent Review and the terms of reference of the Independent Panel of Experts.

The Panel is interested in receiving information in connection with each element of its mission:

- review, examine and assess WWF's role in connection with the BuzzFeed and Kathmandu Post allegations;
- propose to WWF suitable measures, procedures and processes to prevent similar allegations and occurrences in the future; and
- advise on future approaches to spatial conservation.

Submissions should be addressed to independentreview2019@gmail.com. They will not be shared with the WWF or other third parties without the explicit permission of the submitter. Information received in submissions may be used in the public report of the Independent Review, unless the submitter requests that the information be kept confidential.
